### **LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PANEL ON PUBLIC SERVICE**

#### **Supplementary information on civil servants subject to disciplinary action for offences/misconduct related to abuse of official position**

At the meeting of the Panel on Public Service held on 29 May 2009, the Administration undertook to provide a breakdown (by year and by categories) of the 140 cases where civil servants had been subject to disciplinary action for offences or misconduct related to abuse of official position during the five-year period from April 2004 to March 2009, and during the previous five-year period if available.

2. The Administration has started to keep the relevant statistics since April 2000 only. The requested information since April 2000 is set out at **Annex**.
