Under the Open Data Policy of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (the Government), the government job vacancies information being advertised on the online Government Vacancies Enquiry System is released in machine readable format (JSON file format). This document provides information of data structure and data fields of the JSON file of the government job vacancies to data users who have adequate knowledge of JSON file format.
